Banns are usually read on the first three Sundays in the month before your wedding date at the main Sunday service which is 10am for St Peter's Hale. Please ensure that you give us enough time to read your banns.

As well as being a legal requirement, your banns readings are special public occasions when people in church hear of your intention to marry and pray for you. It's an exciting and happy time, so you're welcome to invite your family and friends to hear your banns too, if you'd like.

Once the banns have been read you will be issued with a certificate that you should give to the Vicar of the church where you are getting married.

There is a charge for the readings of banns and the certificate which currently totals £40. This can be paid via cheque made payable to St Peter's Hale PCC or via BACS transfer to: Nat West Bank, Sort Code 51 61 11, Account Number 82472327 quoting your name and invoice number.
